Amaravati golden destination for investors, says Naidu

Amaravati: Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu asked the officials of Capital Region Development Authority (CRDA) and Municipal Administration Minister P Narayana to attract investments by highlighting opportunities including abundant water resources and 21 days permission clearance policy.

The CRDA officials will take part in the Infrastructure Round Table meeting which is scheduled to be held in Singapore for three days from September 25.

Discussing with the CRDA officials ahead of their visit, the Chief Minister pointed out that the State had attracted 1.35 lakh investments at industrial summit which was held in Vizag.

In an informal talk with the officials over phone on Sunday, Chandrababu Naidu asked them to give a call to investors and industrialists to invest in Amaravati as it is a golden destination for global investors.

He assured them of best infrastructure and abundant power, water supply and reminded them that the permissions will be ac-

corded within 21 days through a single window system.

He suggested them to inform the international infrastructure companies that government of India gave Amaravati the first Greenfield smart city status and sanctioned Rs 500 crore through Ministry of Urban Development in a phased manner. More funding is all set to follow for the capital, he reiterated.

"I went to Mumbai and convinced Raheja management to invest in Hyderabad. They have agreed to provide a minimum of 100 jobs for each acre allotted to Raheja. In a much better situation, the people's capital Amaravati drew the attention of investors in Japan, Singapore and USA in a short span of time. The

motto of this tour should be to attract infrastructure developers as well as investors by showcasing growth opportunities in Amaravati. My plans about infrastructure development in Amaravati need to be blended with innovative capabilities of infrastructure players in the conference."

Principal Secretary Ajay Jain said, "The roundtable is considered as premium platform for discussion between government representatives, policy makers, investors and infrastructure companies about infrastructure projects in Asia. Our team will present investment opportunities and scope of infrastructure development in Andhra Pradesh, in particular Amaravati. The organisers of the round-table have set up a

separate session for the State and opportunities in Amaravati."


Besides, CRDA Commissioner Cherukuri Sridhar reminded of special cell that has been set up to clear investment proposals and give necessary clearances for investors. He assured that all the process will be transparent and swift action shall be taken to clear infrastructure and investment proposals due to the presence of technical and economy experts.

Commissioner further reminded the quick decision taken by CRDA to clear the proposal of Vellore Institute of Technology (VIT) in a record period of 24 hours.

He said that 1100 companies would attend the meeting in Singapore. Top companies would be invited to invest in projects in Amaravati, he added.

The team members including special commissioner of AP Capital Region Development Authority Rama Manohara Rao, Additional Commissioner S Shan Mohan and CEO of AP Economic Development Board Krishna Kishore are among those who left for Singapore.



Vizag–Chennai Industrial Corridor, is a key part of the East Coast Economic Corridor (ECEC), India's first coastal corridor. VCIC is aligned with the Golden Quadrilateral and is poised to play a critical role in driving India's Act East Policy and Make in India campaign.

Sri City is a planned integrated business city (township) located 55 km north of Chennai on NH 5 in the state of Andhra Pradesh, India abutting Tamil Nadu border. Much of the Sri City area is in Chittoor District and a smaller area along the NH5 is in Nellore District of AP.

The Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SHAR), India's satellite/rocket launching centre is located at Sriharikota, on the eastern side of the Pulicat Lake which separates Sri City and the satellite launching station.

AP to develop 14 Smart Cities across state

In an effort to decentralise development, the TD government has decided to upgrade 14 cities into Smart Cities. While Visakhapatnam, Tirupati and Kakinada are part of the Centre's Smart Cities Mission, the state will focus on Kurnool, Kadapa, Anantapur, Chittoor, Nellore, Ongole, Machilipatnam, Eluru, Rajahmundry, Vizianagaram and Srikakulam.

Recently, the state government launched special purpose vehicles for implementing its mission in Anantapur, Eluru, Kurnool, Ongole and Srikakulam.

Speaking at the Mahanadu here on Monday, Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu said development should not be confined to the capital Amaravati or major cities such as Visakhapatnam or Tirupati.

"These 14 smart cities will get dedicated indus-

trial park as well as infrastructure. The rate of urbanisation in Andhra Pradesh stands at 29 per cent. Urbanisation accelerates the development of a state and creates more wealth, which has happened in the case of Chennai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, etc," said Mr Naidu.

Vizag, Tirupati and Kakinada will each get ₹500 crore for the next five years from the Centre, and the state government give an equal matching grant. These cities will go for PPP mode for some projects, while the government will undertake some projects.

For the state-sponsored Smart Cities, funds for the development of these cities will be solely spent by the state government.

Government whip Kuna Ravi Kumar explained that the Smart City proposals in Vizag with an estimated cost of about ₹1,584 crore and in Tirupati at an estimated cost of ₹1,610 crore primarily focussed on the IT component, e-governance and physical and social infrastructure.

"Vizag will get smart schools, 24x7 water supply, public bike sharing, e-rickshaws, efficient urban mobility, disaster management, etc. The area surrounding the airport in Tirupati is being developed into an IT hub and the city will have a waste-to-energy plant. Orvakal in Kurnool district will get an industrial hub in more than 10,000 acres. Piped gas network, science centre, solar rooftops, e-schools are part of the smart city proposals in Kakinada," said Mr Ravi Kumar.

While Visakhapatnam, Tirupati and Kakinada are part of the Centre's Smart Cities Mission, the state will focus on Kurnool, Kadapa, Anantapur, Chittoor, Nellore, Ongole, Machilipatnam, Eluru, Rajahmundry, Vizianagaram and Srikakulam.

Vizag, Tirupati and Kakinada will each get Rs 500 crore (approx. SGD 100 million) over the next five years from the Centre, and the state government will give a matching grant.
