



An initiative to provide a platform for participants to be part of the ecosystem of stakeholders for Smart Cities with global innovations as the driving force





Schedule for the Smart City Global Call 2017 – Vietnam

<p>19 July – 18 September</p>	<p><u>Smart City Global Call Innovation Challenge 2017 is live (CFC with Smart Cities team)</u></p> <p>Call for Collaboration (CFC) with startups/SMEs with Smart City Solutions into the cities of Da Nang and Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC), Vietnam</p>
<p>18 September</p>	<p>30 companies shortlisted and invited to pitch to selection committee (online)</p>
<p>18 - 29 September</p>	<p>If shortlisted, online pitch will be arranged with selection committee any day within this period. Only a 10 min session</p>
<p>2 October</p>	<p>Up to 15 finalists announced</p>
<p>9 - 11 October</p>	<p>3-Days Local orientation workshop held in Da Nang (all expenses paid trip). There will be exposure to city planners, program mentors and the local demand drivers during this workshop</p>
<p>12 October - 30 November</p>	<p>There will be shaping of solutions with test bedding and piloting in Da Nang and HCMC</p>
<p>1 December</p>	<p>Demo Day when top three winners will be chosen. Top three smart city solutions will be used for real-implementation</p>
