Our Motivation

- A recent Government Technology white paper "Evolution of Smart Cities and Connected Communities", reported that the market value of **smart city projects** worldwide would jump from **USD14.85B in 2015** to a predicted value of **USD34.35B by 2020**.
- The number of Smart Cities projects would rise 38% to more than **235 initiatives** in 2016 from 170 at the end of 2013. A key driver of this growth was the ongoing trend of **global urbanisation (66% of world population in 2050)**
- This Smart Cities Roundtable allows the participants to discuss the **Critical Success Factors of Smart Cities projects**.

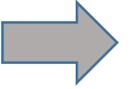
Example 'technology' related experience

Helped formulate Singapore's (as well as the UAE's) food security strategy which included the use of advanced technologies and city based food production

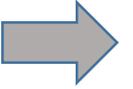

Funding Eligibility

Up to \$50,000

or 90 % of Qualifying Cost
(whichever is lower)

Supported cost items:

- Professional Services
- Fees & Materials
- Marketing & Publicity

Disbursement timeline:

- 50 % of project costs upon approval
- Balance 50 % of project costs upon project completion

Who can apply?

Individuals

At least a team of 2 individuals 18 years and above, one being a Singaporean. Individuals below 18 years old may apply through their schools.

Schools

MOE Primary, Secondary, Junior Colleges, ITEs, Polytechnic, Universities, Private Educational Institutions

Organisations

Registered under Registrar of Society (ROS) or Accounting & Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA).
